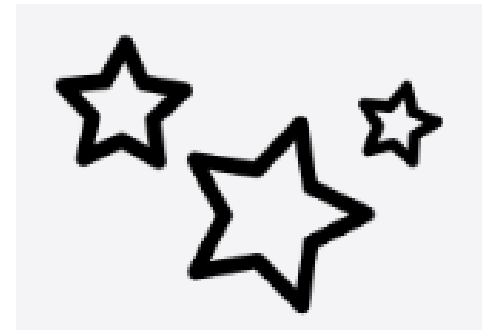

POSITIVE POINTS



Points available every half term:

- ✓ Tutee of the week, nominated by your Tutor every Monday morning: **10 points**

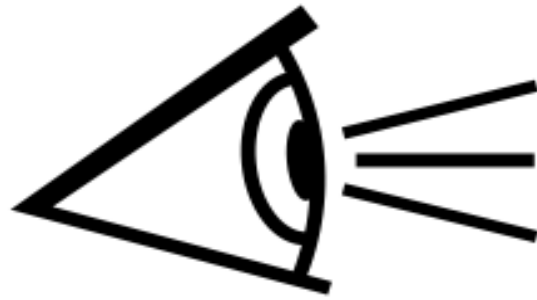

Opportunity to reflect on behaviour.
60 minutes detention the following day.
Parents/carers informed.
1 day worth of lessons in IE.

RED LINES BREACH

Parents/carers informed.
1 negative behaviour point

START OF LESSON

Arrive calmly.
“Good morning Miss/Sir”
“Good afternoon Miss/Sir”

Enter the classroom quietly. Sit down in your allocated seat. Take out equipment.

Immediately copy the date and title.
Complete your starter task in silence.

END OF LESSON

Pack equipment away calmly when you are asked to by the Teacher.

Wait behind your chairs to be dismissed. Check your uniform.
You should be silent.

Leave the room calmly when you are dismissed by the Teacher.

Red lines breach examples (at any time during school day)

- Persistent refusal to follow adult instructions / requests
- Fighting / inappropriate physical contact
- Verbal abuse to students or adult
- Bullying
- Dangerous / anti-social behaviour
- Swearing at adults
- Aggressive or threatening behaviour to adults or other students
- Possession of prohibited items e.g. vapes, drugs, banned items, weapons.
