Dear Parents and carers.

Although this is a short week, we have packed a lot into it!

Staff are reinforcing behaviour messages with all pupils, especially around uniform. When worn correctly, the MVC uniform looks really smart, especially the new skirts. Please encourage your child to attend school in the correct uniform; every child should wear a blue logo-ed jumper over their shirt as the weather gets colder, along with a suitable waterproof/showerproof coat. We do not allow hoodies to be worn in place of school jumpers or coats.

All pupils must also wear a tie – we have a few spare ones to lend for the day in case your child has forgotten theirs. Staff are also challenging every pupil who is flouting our jewellery rules. No jewellery of any description is permitted, except one pair of plain, undecorated stud earrings; any jewellery worn to school will be confiscated, and parents must come to school to collect it.

The majority of pupils who are spoken to about their uniform infringements are correcting them immediately - this shows that for most pupils, a simple conversation or reminder is enough.

We continue to deal with the 'overflow' of unkind remarks and the sharing of inappropriate material online by pupils outside of school hours. The hurt caused spills over into the school environment and is taking up more and more of our staff's time. Please do look through your child's phone and monitor their use of social media; help your child learn good habits early, that will serve them well throughout life.


